



PCCE AGM

All schools are invited and encouraged to participate in our **Annual General Meeting** on March 7 at 10:00 AM MT. For a school to be considered present at the meeting, *both a Board representative and an Educator representative must be in attendance*. Living

Lent begins this week and between now and Easter, we will use this section of The Page to encourage you in your preparation for Easter, but this week, we'll start with a short overview of Lent.

- Lent begins 46 days before Easter on Ash Wednesday (February 18 this year) and ends on Holy Saturday, the day before Easter.
- Lent is 40 days long, as Sundays are not included
- Some key dates: Ash Wednesday, Palm Sunday (the last Sunday before Easter), Maundy Thursday (remembering the Last Supper), Good Friday, Holy Saturday, Easter Sunday.
- 40 days of Lent is symbolic of other Biblical events: Jesus' 40 days of fasting and temptation in the wilderness, Moses' 40 days on Mount Sinai, 40 days of rain in the Flood, Israel's 40 years of wandering in the desert
- A common Lenten practice includes fasting/giving something up with the opportunity to replace the time/focus/resources usually associated with that "thing" with more reflective and meditative time with God with the anticipation of deeper intimacy with the Lord.
- We invite our PCCE schools so use the Contemplating Lent resource noted below.

Update on Funding Removal Campaign

Last week Wednesday, the organizers of the 'Alberta Funds Public Schools Citizen Initiative' conceded that their petition had not met the required threshold of signatures to trigger a referendum. The proposed referendum would have promoted the termination of public funding for independent schools in Alberta.

This outcome brings much-needed stability for our independent schools. The conversation surrounding educational choice in Alberta, however, will continue to require our attention and involvement. It is an essential conversation that addresses the very nature of our province's history and identity.

We want to express our appreciation for the work of AISCA to advocate for our independent schools and promote a diverse, inclusive, and parent-driven education system. We are similarly grateful for many of you who spoke up on various platforms and in many conversations in support for choice in education.
