Abbotsford Christian School is currently accepting applications for an **ELEMENTARY MUSIC TEACHER**. This position is full-time, salaried, and begins September 1, 2024.

At Abbotsford Christian School, the elementary campus music teacher recognizes the importance of whole-child development and faith formation as an integral part of music education. The music teacher is responsible for planning and implementing the music fine arts program with a distinctively Christian vision for grade 1 to grade 4 students. This role involves competently teaching fundamental music concepts, as well as providing instruction in vocal and instrumental technique. The music teacher engages students in active music-making through singing, playing instruments, and ensemble participation.

The teacher is responsible for planning and executing various student performances throughout the year (for example: Christmas concert, spring musical, grandfriends day, and Honorary Members \banquet, etc.). As an extracurricular, the teacher directs the elementary school choir, Joyful Sounds. The music teacher creates a positive and inclusive learning environment that cultivates a sense of awe and wonder for God's creative work through the study and appreciation of music.
